

## 1<sup>st</sup> Jamaada al Thaani 1428

**Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2007** for Mu'mineen residing in Western Europe and the Americas except for the southern parts of South America.

**Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2007** for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the first sighting of the crescent should InshaaAllah occur in North Western Europe on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2007. Mu'mineen in London should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1<sup>st</sup> Jamaada al Thaani 1428 will be on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2007 for Mu'mineen residing in Western Europe and the Americas except for the southern parts of South America. Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2007 for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.
