

1st Muharram 1425 – Sunday 22nd February 2004 for Mu'mineen all over the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the crescent would not be sighted anywhere on earth on Friday 20th February 2004. The first sighting should InshaaAllah occur in the Pacific Ocean on Saturday 21st February, 2004. Mu'mineen in Australia should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Muharram 1425 will be on Sunday 22nd February, 2004 for Mu'mineen all over the world.
