Saturday 19th June 2004 for Mu'mineen residing in North and West Africa, Europe, the Caribbean, North America, top half of South America and Canada.

Sunday 20th June 2004 for Mu'mineen residing in the rest of the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the first sighting of the crescent should InshaaAllah occur in the Mediterranean Sea on Friday 18th June, 2004. Mu'mineen in Tripoli should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Jamaada al Ula 1425 will be on Saturday 19th June, 2004 for Mu'mineen residing in North and West Africa, Europe, the Caribbean, North America, top half of South America and Canada.

Sunday 20th June, 2004 for Mu'mineen residing in the rest of the world.
