Saturday 16th October 2004 for Mu'mineen all over the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the first sighting of the crescent should InshaaAllah occur in the South Pacific Ocean on Thursday 14th October, 2004. Mu'mineen in Fiji should be the first to be able to sight the crescent on Friday 15th October, 2004.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Ramadhan 1425 will be on Saturday 16th October, 2004 for Mu'mineen all over the world.
