Zainabiya Health Centre sees 175 patients in its first month - Pottenahali, India

On 1st May 2009, The World Federation opened the Zainabiya Health Centre in Pottenahali, India, benefitting both the residents as well as nearby villages. With only 1 month in operation, the Centre has treated more than 175 patients. Pottenahali is a village only a couple of hours' drive from Bangalore city. Until now, there were no primary health care facilities to help and support the local villagers. The nearest centre was over 10 kilometers away.
