Ramadhan Relief 1427 – Imam e Zamana Mission, Hyderabad

Through the WF Ramadhan Relief, the Imam e Zamana Mission in Hyderabad distributed relief packages to over 2,500 beneficiaries, as per a report prepared by Salim Peerbhoy. The relief packages included 10 Kg rice, 1-2 Kg Oil, 2 Kg sugar, 1 Kg Channa daal, 5 Kg Wheat, tea powder, 1 Kg dates, and 1 Kg Salt. Cash donations were also distributed to needy families, including Moulanas, and to mosques to support Iftaar programs.
