Wednesday 17th March 2010 for Mu'mineen residing in United Kingdom, Canada, USA and Central America.

Thursday 18th March 2010 for Mu'mineen residing in the rest of the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the first sighting of the crescent should InshaaAllah occur in Northern Atlantic Ocean on Tuesday 16th March, 2010. Mu'mineen in London should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Rabi' al Thaani 1431 will be on Wednesday 17th March, 2010 for Mu'mineen residing in United Kingdom Canada, USA and Central America. Thursday 18th March 2010 for Mu'mineen residing in the rest of the world.
