Saturday 15th May 2010 for Mu'mineen residing in USA, Canada and Central America.

Sunday 16th May 2010 for Mu'mineen residing in the rest of the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the first sighting of the crescent should InshaaAllah occur in North Atlantic Ocean on Friday 14th May, 2010. Mu'mineen in Newfoundland should be the first to be able to sight the crescent on Friday 14th May 2010.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Jamaada al Thaani 1431 will be on Saturday 15th May, 2010 for Mu'mineen residing in USA, Canada and Central America. Sunday 16th May 2010 for Mu'mineen residing in the rest of the world.
