Tuesday 17th August 2004 for Mu'mineen residing in the Caribbean, Southern belt of North America and Northern South America.

Wednesday 18th August 2004 for Mu'mineen residing in the rest of the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the first sighting of the crescent should InshaaAllah occur in the Caribbean Sea on Monday 16th August, 2004. Mu'mineen in Jamaica should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Rajab 1425 will be on Tuesday 17th August, 2004 for Mu'mineen residing in the Caribbean, Southern belt of North America and Northern South America. Wednesday 18th August, 2004 for Mu'mineen residing in the rest of the world.
