Tuesday 27th June 2006 for Mu'mineen all over the world except for those residing in New Zealand and Australia.

Wednesday 28th June 2006 for Mu'mineen residing in New Zealand and Australia.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the crescent would not be sighted anywhere on earth on Sunday 25th June 2006. The first sighting of the crescent should InshaaAllah occur in Northern Asia on Monday 26th June, 2006. Mu'mineen in Beijing, China should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Jamaada al Thaani 1427 will be on Tuesday 27th June, 2006 for Mu'mineen all over the world except for those residing in New Zealand and Australia.
