

1st Muharram 1432

Tuesday 7th December 2010 for Mu'mineen residing in Central and West Africa, USA, Central and South America.

Wednesday 8th December 2010 for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the first sighting of the crescent should InshaaAllah occur in Central Africa on Monday 6th December, 2010. Mu'mineen in Zimbabwe should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Muharram 1432 will be on Tuesday 7th December, 2010 for Mu'mineen residing in Central and West Africa, USA, Central and South America. Wednesday 8th December, 2010 for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.
