

1st Rajab 1431

Monday 14th June 2010 for Mu'mineen all over the world except for those residing in New Zealand and Northern Asia.

Tuesday 15th June 2010 for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the first sighting should InshaaAllah occur in the Western Pacific Ocean on Sunday 13th June, 2010. Mu'mineen in Fiji should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Rajab 1431 will be on Monday 14th June, 2010 for Mu'mineen all over the world except for those residing in New Zealand and Northern Asia for whom it will be on Tuesday 15th June, 2010.
