Thousands benefit from wells in rural Pakistan

Thanks to the fundraising efforts of a group of UK philanthropists in February 2011, The World Federation through its Ali Asghar Water Appeal donated £7,700 to the building of 5 new water wells. 2 of these wells have been completed in the villages of Gano Fakhir Gopang and Khan village. 2 more wells are scheduled to be completed by 25th Ramadhan.

Ramadhan Relief 1432 eases food shortages in Kenya

Over 2,500 families in Kenya have received food parcels through the Ramadhan Relief Fund to help them with the worst drought for 60 years.

Annual Report: Approx 10,000 patients treated by Zainabia Blood Bank and Thalassaemia centre – Hyderabad, Pakistan

There are 520 patients registered with the centre. The majority are Thalassaemic patients but there some with Hemophilia and Aplastic Anaemia. 450 pints of blood per month is being transfused to children suffering from this disease.
