The first sighting should InshaaAllah occur in the East Indies on Sunday 18th February, 2007. Mu'mineen in Jakarta, Indonesia should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Safar 1428 will be on Monday 19th February, 2007 for Mu'mineen all over the world except for those residing in New Zealand and Australia. Tuesday 20th February, 2007 for Mu'mineen residing in New Zealand and Australia.
