

1st Jamaada al Ula 1426

Wednesday 8th June 2005 for Mu'mineen residing in North and West Africa, Southern Europe, the Caribbean, top half of South America, North America and Canada.

Thursday 9th June 2005 for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the crescent would not be sighted anywhere on earth on Monday 6th June 2005. The first sighting of the crescent should InshaaAllah occur in the Mediterranean on Tuesday 7th June, 2005. Mu'mineen in Tripoli should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Jamaada al Ula 1426 will be on Wednesday 8th June, 2005 for Mu'mineen residing in North and West Africa, Southern Europe, the Caribbean, North America, top half of South America and Canada.

Thursday 9th June, 2005 for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.
