

1st Sha'baan 1428

Tuesday 14th August 2007 for Mu'mineen residing in South and Central America, Caribbean and the Southern Belt of USA.

Wednesday 15th August 2007 for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the first sighting should InshaaAllah occur in South Atlantic Ocean on Monday 13th August, 2007. Mu'mineen in Brazil should be the first to be able to sight the crescent.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Sha'baan 1428 will be on Tuesday 14th August, 2007 for Mu'mineen residing in South and Central America, Caribbean and the Southern Belt of USA. Wednesday 15th August, 2007 for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.
