Saturday 13th October 2007 for Mu'mineen residing in New Zealand, Australia, South East Asia, India, Pakistan, Middle East, Africa and the Americas excluding Canada.

Sunday 14th October 2007 for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.

Based on our community sighting criteria, the first sighting of the crescent should InshaaAllah occur in South Pacific Ocean on Thursday 11th October, 2007. Mu'mineen in Fiji should be the first to be able to sight the crescent on Friday 12th October 2007.

Should the crescent be sighted as expected, in accordance with the rulings of Ayatullah Seestani (based on the Theory of Differing Horizons), 1st Shawwaal 1428 will be on Saturday 13th October, 2007 for Mu'mineen residing in New Zealand, Australia, South East Asia, India, Pakistan, Middle East, Africa and the Americas excluding Canada.

Sunday 14th October, 2007 for Mu'mineen in the rest of the world.
